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the poll, it will, however, pick two new leaders in each state to spearhead its campaign. Bhattacharjee, 71, has health-related issues and Achuthanandan will be 92 at the time the party will face the next assembly elections in Kerala. Both the former chief ministers are no longer regular members of party's Central Committee and Politburo.

In April this year, the party had elected Yechury as its new general secretary after its top brass got re-elected. Both states are crucial for the party as well as for the larger interest of the Left Front. Even as snatching victory in a three-corner contest featuring Trinamool Congress and BJP in Bengal looks a daunting chal-

lenge, a win in Kerala can bolster the Left's relevance not just in the state but in the national political scenario as well. "It is too early to predict who can be the face of our campaign. But yes, we have to look at new faces," says a senior leader.

Party insiders suggest that picking a possible chief ministerial candidate will be a relatively easier task in Bengal where the party had to bite the dust in 2011, after a 34-year record term. But in the faction-ridden Kerala unit, the party may need more negotiations to pick its right face. Kodiari Balakrishnan and MA Baby are seen as possible choices in Kerala, where the party is better placed to win the polls.

NEW DELHI: With Maggi continuing to be off the shelves in the market place, the government Friday said that its manufacturer Nestle was "not forthcoming" on giving reasons for the high MSG levels found in some of the packages.

Health minister J P Nadda said in Lok Sabha that the government did not ban Maggi but had asked Nestle to recall the product and give reasons for the high Monosodium Glutamate (MSG) level found in it.
